We developed a new scale to evaluate the quality of couples' agreements about outside sexual partners. The scale was validated and has good reliability and is predictive of risk among couples. Additionally I was awarded funding for an NIMH funded grant to follow couples longitudinally. These studies represent the largest longitudinal sample of gay male couples since the beginning of the AIDS epidemic. Findings from these studies were presented at the International AIDS Conference, the Annual Conference for the Society of the Scientific Study of Sexuality and the

bi-annual meeting of the International Association of Relationship Research. Two studies where I am a co-investigator are underway thus, I am actively working with Kyung-Hee Choi on her Social networking study to promote the female condom and with Mallory Johnson his study investigating relationship dynamics and adherence to HIV treatments among gay couples.
