


CRGS invites YOU to apply for the 2009

What is the New Faculty Program at CRGS?

Every year The Center for Research on Gender and Sexuality (CRGS) invites one San Francisco State University faculty member to become part of the CRGS Research Faculty Team. To be eligible, this visiting faculty member must be tenure-track or tenured and currently conducting research that broadly addresses issues on gender and sexuality, as well as have an interest in developing innovative grant proposals and research projects surrounding these subjects.

Why CRGS?

CRGS is an interdisciplinary community of SFSU faculty, students, and staff dedicated to studying ground-breaking social science research questions, methods, and theories, and training new investigators. Frequently working in collaboration with community organizations, CRGS is committed to producing new and useful knowledge about sexuality and gender.

Together with a supportive community of like-minded researchers, faculty from the New Faculty Program will be an integral part of the CRGS goal to increase the breadth of sexuality research conducted at The Center.

Visiting faculty will work with experienced colleagues available to provide peer reviews, have access to brown bag and seminar lectures from experts in the field, and work out of a centrally located office space at the SFSU downtown campus.
